Rotel's new RX-1052 (\$899) combines audiophile-grade stereo sonics with basic video-switching features, as well as multiroom capability. In addition to 100-watt stereo via two sets of four-way A and B speaker outputs, it also incorporates three sets of remote zone outputs. Coupled with a multichannel amplifier, the RX-1052 can feed as many as four remote zones, controllable via three independent IR links and 12-volt trigger outputs, and an addressable RS-232 serial port. ### >>> HYBRID IN-WALLS FROM MARTINLOGAN

MartinLogan is introducing the architecturally-inspired high-performance Voyage and Passage in-wall loudspeakers. Both models feature the company's ATF (Advanced Thin Film) transducers, which consist of a micro-thin, low-mass diaphragm with an ultra-light, etched conductive aluminum surface suspended between two high field strength neodymium super magnet arrays. Extruded and milled, the Voyage and Passage aluminum chassis exhibits rigidity capable of stiffening the wall in which they are installed, thus minimizing acoustically-destructive vibrations.
